"Yes, you did."


"I have showed you as a model that you should do as I have done for you. I tell you the truth. No servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him.


I am a bad person. I don't want to say bad words. But my friends said I were a fool if I would say bad words like them. So I said bad words at a kid who built the blocks faster than me.

A large number of people followed Jesus, walking. Among them, there were women who cried and bit their heart for him.


Jesus turned and said to them,

Jews.'"


"What I have written, I have written. No more requests."


Jesus! It's so sad. Why didn't you drink the wine mixed with gall? They said it could ease your pain.

In the same way, the chief priests and the elders made fun of him.


"He saved others, but he can't save himself! "

Then he said to Jesus


"Jesus! Remember me when you come into your kingdom."
