



Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried.


He descended into Hell; the third day He rose again from the dead;

20 So he got up and went to his father." But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him.

21 "The son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.' 22 "But the father said to his servants, 'Quick! Bring the best robe and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet.

23 Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's have a feast and celebrate.

24 For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' So they began to celebrate.

Bible Story





MONDAY

Noah and his family enter the Ark

1 The Lord then said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and your whole family, because I have found you righteous in this generation.

2 Take with you seven pairs of every kind of clean animal, a male and its mate, and one pair of every kind of unclean animal, a male and its mate,

3 and also seven pairs of every kind of bird, male and female, to keep their various kinds alive throughout the earth.

4 Seven days from now I will send rain on the earth for forty days and forty nights, and I will wipe from the face of the earth every living creature I have made."

5 And Noah did all that the Lord commanded him.

Genesis 7:1-5

Bible story

God said to Noah:

"Bring your family and enter the ark. I have seen righteousness in you."

Noah was very happy.

"Yes LORD! The ark is finished. I will obey and enter the ark with my family and animals. Just like You told me to do."

Noah spoke to his family.

"God told us all to go inside the ark. My sons Shem, Ham, Japheth! Bring your wives with you as well." God spoke to Noah.

"For 40 days, day and night, I will pour rain and destroy every living creature in this earth."

When Noah entered the ark, God allowed him to rest for 7 days. And on the promised day, rain started to come down. Roads were filled with water. Houses drowned under water. For 40 days, rain came down and destroyed all humans, birds, and animals on earth except those inside the ark.

40 days inside the Ark

17 For forty days the flood kept coming on the earth, and as the waters increased they lifted the ark high above the earth.

18 The waters rose and increased greatly on the earth, and the ark floated on the surface of the water.

19 They rose greatly on the earth, and all the high mountains under the entire heavens were covered.

20 The waters rose and covered the mountains to a depth of more than fifteen cubits.

21 Every living thing that moved on land perished—birds, livestock, wild animals, all the creatures that swarm over the earth, and all mankind.

22 Everything on dry land that had the breath of life in its nostrils died.

23 Every living thing on the face of the earth was wiped out; people and animals and the creatures that move along the ground and the birds were wiped from the earth. Only Noah was left, and those with him in the ark.

Genesis 7:17-23

Bible Story

After 40 days, the rain stopped. Noah sent a dove outside, which brought back a freshly plucked olive leaf.

God told Nah:

"Come out of the ark with all your family and animals. I will bless you and make you fruitful."

Noah came out of the ark and worshiped God. God saw Noah and was very pleased.

God said:

"Noah. I will never again wipe all living creatures on earth with water. This rainbow is a sign of my promise."

Noah was very happy. He received many blessings from God and lived a good life.

Remember that God is watching you. Let us be good children and make God happy.

5 "Go back and tell Hezekiah, the ruler of my people, 'This is what the Lord, the God of your father David, says: I have heard your prayer and seen your tears; I will heal you. On the third day from now you will go up to the temple of the Lord.

6 I will add fifteen years to your life. And I will deliver you and this city from the hand of the king of Assyria. I will defend this city for my sake and for the sake of my servant David."

2 Kings 20:3-6

Testimony

Bible story

Jesus taught the crowd on how to become a righteous person using the parable of the Good Samaritan.

There was once a man who was traveling a long way.

But during the way, the traveler was attacked by robbers. The robbers stole everything that the traveler had and beat him harshly. The traveler really needed help because he was about to die.

A priest walked along the road and saw the traveler. However, the priest pretended he did not see the man and passed by without giving help.

Then, a Levite walked along the road and saw the traveler.

"I am too busy! I am sure someone else will help him."

The Levite simply shook his head and passed by the man without giving help as well.

The traveler was left alone in pain, without help from anyone.

35 The next day he took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper. 'Look after him,' he said, 'and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.'

36 "Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?"

37 The expert in the law replied, "The one who had mercy on him."

Jesus told him, "Go and do likewise."

When the Samaritan saw the traveler who was beaten by the robbers, the Samaritan went to the traveler to give help.

"You are really hurt. Let me help you."

The Samaritan bandaged the wounds and took the traveler to an inn.

"Please take care of this traveler until I return. He is hurt. I will pay for all of the expense."

The traveler was a stranger to the Samaritan. Still, the Samaritan took care of the traveler and paid for him to get better.

From the Priest, Levite, and the Samaritan, who was a neighbor to the traveler?
What kind of neighbor are you?

When someone asks us for help, we must think about the Samaritan. We must think of Jesus. Jesus gave His Life for us. Thanks to His Love, we received salvation to Heaven. Just like Jesus, we should love our neighbors, family and friends. Let's become a good Samaritan and help others!





3 They said to each other, "Come, let's make bricks and bake them thoroughly." They used brick instead of stone, and tar for mortar.

4 Then they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city, with a tower that reaches to the heavens, so that we may make a name for ourselves; otherwise, we will be scattered over the face of the whole earth."

5 But the Lord came down to see the city and the tower the people were building.

Genesis 11:1-5

Bible story

Noah's children were blessed and numerous. They lived all over the world amongst other people.
