

When he had said this, he fell asleep. (Act 7:60)





"Now look! It is the Holy City, beautiful heaven."


It had a great, high wall with twelve gates, and with twelve angels at the gates. It shone with the glory of God, and its brilliance was like that of a very precious jewel.
